



Quality Technician

Responsible for assisting Quality Control team in driving company-wide focus on continuous improvement, ongoing yield and reliability improvement; setting quality assurance testing models for analysis of raw materials, materials in process and finished products; and performing inspection of raw materials, materials in process and finished products.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct routine and non-routine analyses of in-process materials, raw materials, environmental samples, finished goods, or stability samples.
- Interpret test results, compare them to established specifications and control limits, and make recommendations on appropriateness of data for release.
- Calibrate, validate, or maintain laboratory equipment.
- Ensure that lab cleanliness and safety standards are maintained.
- Perform visual inspections of finished products.
- Develop and implement programs to address quality problems related to production, incoming materials, or any other contributor to product quality.
- Catalogue defect modes and drive company-wide focus for ongoing yield and reliability improvements.
- Design and conduct tests, metrics and reports for product performance and quality.
- Review test reports and customer specifications for product performance and quality.
- Assist production and process personnel in development of programs to address problems related to production, materials, safety and quality.
- Coordinate and network with operations team to plan work, set targets and ensure finished products meet quality standards.
- Reinforces Company's safety procedures, rules, and regulations.
- Other duties as required.
